This ordering guide explains how federal agencies and their approved contractors can purchase mission-based IT service solutions from JR Software Solutions Inc (JRSS) under the NASA SEWP VI Government-Wide Acquisition Contract. It is published per SEWP SOW A.6, is suitable for download and printing, and is updated within 10 business days of every contract modification.

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1 · SEWP VI Overview

NASA SEWP (Solutions for Enterprise-Wide Procurement), pronounced "soup," provides the latest Information Technology, Communication, and Audio-Visual (ITC/AV) solutions and services for all federal agencies and their approved contractors. Created in 1993, SEWP was the first Government-Wide Acquisition Contract (GWAC) in the federal acquisition space and now supports more than 50,000 orders a year. The program is self-funded through a 0.34% usage fee embedded in contract pricing.

SEWP VI is a multiple-award GWAC. JRSS holds a Category C contract — Mission-Based ITC/AV Service Solutions — covering customized, program-level IT service solutions, with ancillary products available only in support of those services.

4 · What Is in Scope

SEWP VI provides a broad suite of ITC/AV solutions and services across three scope categories: Category A (ITC/AV Solutions), Category B (Enterprise-Wide ITC/AV Service Solutions), and Category C (Mission-Based ITC/AV Service Solutions). JRSS holds Category C. Under it, JRSS delivers customized, mission- and program-level IT service solutions, including:

- AI & machine learning — decision support, predictive analytics, secure GenAI, and agentic RAG
- Intelligent automation — RPA and AI agents with human oversight and audit trails
- Data & analytics — enterprise data platforms, medallion architecture, mission dashboards
- Application development — modernization, citizen-facing platforms, ERP implementation
- Cybersecurity & zero trust — architecture, ICAM, continuous monitoring
- DevSecOps & secure cloud — secure CI/CD and infrastructure-as-code on Azure and AWS

5 · Ordering Process

Step 1 — Request a quote. Agencies request quotes through the SEWP Quote Request Tool (QRT) at sewp.nasa.gov — the recommended method for documenting fair opportunity — or contact JRSS directly to discuss the requirement first.

Step 2 — Receive the JRSS quote. JRSS responds through the SEWP system with clearly stated validity dates, and honors any order submitted within the stated validity period of a quote.

Step 3 — Issue the delivery order. Delivery orders are issued by the customer agency's own contracting office — never by the SEWP Program Management Office — and are routed through the SEWP PMO, which reviews, processes, tracks, and forwards them to JRSS. Any modifications to an order also route through the SEWP PMO.

Payment. Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) and Government Purchase Card are accepted regardless of order size.

6 · Fair Opportunity (Clause A.1.13 Summary)

SEWP VI is a multiple-award GWAC. Per FAR 16.505(b), each contract holder is given a fair opportunity to be considered for each order, and the method for obtaining fair opportunity is at the discretion of the ordering Contracting Officer. Using the SEWP Quote Request Tool automatically includes the contract holders within a selected group and helps document the fair-opportunity decision. Key points of clause A.1.13 (Fair Opportunity and Requests for Quotes):

- Fair opportunity applies at the individual order level per FAR Part 16.505(b), including the SEWP RFQ tools; order-selection documentation is maintained by the issuing procurement office.
- JRSS will not market, quote, or offer for sale any ITC solutions not listed under its contract until they are included in the SEWP database of record and available to all Government end-users.
- Responses to a formal RFQ or Market Research Request may include only items on contract, at prices no greater than the SEWP database of record at the time the quote is issued; if JRSS cannot fully respond, it must submit a No Bid, and unless the RFQ allows partial quotes, responses must be complete.
- Every quote states its validity period, and JRSS honors any order submitted within that period.
- Responses to RFIs and RFQs issued from the SEWP on-line quoting system follow the Contract Holder User Manual (CHUM).
